SUPPLY LIST 2017-2018

Dear Parents,

The following is a list of supplies your preschooler will need beginning with the first day of school:

ALL PRESCHOOL STUDENTS:

- Backpack – school sized
- 1 sturdy 2 pocket folder
- 1 large box of tissues
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 box Crayola crayons (24 count box)
- 1 one inch binder
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 – 12 count pack of swiffer or similar wet mop refills

ONLY P4 STUDENTS:

Dear Parents,

The following is a list of supplies your kindergartner will need beginning with the first day of school:

- Backpack – no wheels
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 pair of Blunt Tip Fiskar scissors
- 2 boxes of classic crayons (no more than 24-count – no twistables or glitter)
- 2 packs of Crayola washable markers, **basic colors**
- 4 **large Elmer's** glue sticks
- 2 two-pocket **plastic** folders with horizontal pockets (no center prongs)
- 1 eraser
- 1 large container Clorox/Lysol Wipes
- 2 large boxes facial tissues (puffs)
- 1 tri-fold mat for nap time (full day kindergarten only)

The following is a list of supplies your first grader will need beginning with the first day of school:

Backpack

2 Mead Composition Books (black & white marble cover) **Wide Ruled**

1 pair of scissors (pointed) (Fiskars are recommended.)

2 boxes of crayons (at least 24)

1 box of **thick** washable markers

1 bottle of Elmer's glue (4 oz. size) **NOT school glue (Elmer's Glue-All is preferred.)**

8 **large white** glue sticks

4 two-pocket folders **with horizontal pockets**

2 pack of 3 x 5 unruled index cards

Girls: 1 box (any brand) of "zipper" lock quart size freezer bags

Boys: 1 box (any brand) of "zipper" lock gallon size freezer bags

1 pack of 12 **#2 lead pencils**, plain, no designs

1 good pencil eraser (**not pencil cap erasers**)

1 box of 24-count (maximum) Crayola Crayons (**basic colors only, no neon or fluorescent**)

2 boxes Crayola markers (**one box of thick; one box of fine; primary colors, washable**)

NO permanent markers, please

1 bottle Elmer's glue (washable, 4 oz.)

2 Elmer's washable glue sticks – **jumbo size** (.77 oz, 22 g)

1 pair of **child's pointed scissors (good quality to cut paper)**

3 two-pocket **plastic** folders, **plain colors: 1 red, 1 green, 1 blue**

1 two-pocket folder (Spanish class)

1 **wooden** 12-inch ruler **with inches and centimeters**

1 large container (75 Count) Clorox or Lysol pull-up wipes

1 large box zip lock bags (quart size)
