Dear Parents,

The following is a list of supplies your preschooler will need beginning with the first day of school:

ALL PRESCHOOL STUDENTS:

- Backpack – school sized
- 1 sturdy 2 pocket folder
- 1 large box of tissues
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 one inch binder
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 extra set of clothes (t-shirt, shorts/pants, socks and underwear)

1 good pencil eraser (**not pencil cap erasers**)

1 box of 24-count (maximum) Crayola Crayons (**basic colors only, no neon or fluorescent**)

2 boxes Crayola markers (**one box of thick; one box of fine; primary colors, washable**)

NO permanent markers, please

1 bottle Elmer's glue (washable, 4 oz.)

2 Elmer's washable glue sticks – **jumbo size** (.77 oz, 22 g)
