Current Student Registration

The Registration Fee/Book Fee of \$270 per student for grades K-8 and Preschool 3 going to P4 is \$100. The Fee is due on February 1, 2018. This fee will reserve your student(s) place for the 2018 – 2019 school year. (This fee becomes non-refundable seven days after tuition is set.)

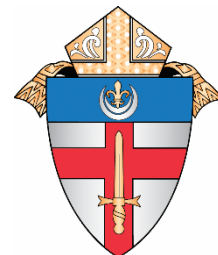
